J. Ward declared the public hearing on the proposed revisions in the Rules of the Oklahoma Board of Nursing to be in session. A notice of the Public Hearing was published in the December 3, 2007, Oklahoma Register. G. McNish gave a summary of written comments received in relation to the Rules proposed under agenda item 1.4.1.

Individuals making public comments in support of the proposed Rule changes were as follows: Mary Peterman, ARNP; Martha Cordova, ARNP; Jenny Maschino, ARNP; and Ragina Holiman, CNS. Individuals speaking in support of the rule change addressed that 46 states allow APNs to prescribe controlled dangerous substances. They indicated that Oklahoma's seven day supply is the most restrictive in the nation. In addition, they spoke of their concerns that the ability of an APN to prescribe only a seven day supply encourages poly-provider and poly-pharmacy use, thereby reducing continuity of care. They also addressed the issues that Medicaid patients face, in that Medicaid only allows a patient to fill a limited number of prescriptions per month. If only a seven day supply can be ordered, four of the prescriptions are already used, which may result in the patient being unable to fill other prescriptions. Those speaking in support of the rule change indicated that advanced practice nurses can already prescribe a 30 day supply of Schedule III – V drugs, but the patient has to make four (4) separate office visits. This becomes expensive with multiple co-payments for patients on limited incomes, and transportation problems may occur because some patients have limited physical capacities. In addition, some insurance companies deny payment when multiple prescriptions are written for patients outside payment parameters. The speakers also noted that a 30 day supply of Schedule III – V drugs is consistent with medication management standards for the safe care of patients.
