The enhanced Nurse Licensure Compact (eNLC) will be enacted when 26 states have passed law adopting the compact or December 31, 2018, whichever occurs soonest. The eNLC will not be implemented until after the Interstate Commission develops rules and sets the implementation date.

K. Glazier notified the Board that HB1886 was signed by Governor Fallin on May 16, 2017, and will permit Board officers to suspend a license if there is an imminent threat to the public with identified requirements to be met within ninety (90) days of the suspension. K. Glazier also reported on legislation the agency is tracking.
